The Graduate School of Offenburg University of Applied Sciences offers six international Master's programs. A Master's is an additional study course which may be pursued after a Bachelor's degree has been completed successfully and it generally takes between 3 and 4 semesters to complete. A Master degree also provides the academic qualification required for pursuing a doctorate degree.

Our Master's degrees have received several awards. In 2008, for example, the Communication and Media Engineering program (CME) was selected by the Association for the Promotion of Science and Humanities in Germany and the [German Academic Exchange Service \(DAAD\)](#) as one of the top 10 international Master's degree programs in Germany.

The Graduate School is supported by the [Advisory Board](#), an independent committee of business leaders who advise the Graduate School regarding the development of its international study programs.
